Sexual Assault Prevention Outreach with Quilcene Rangers

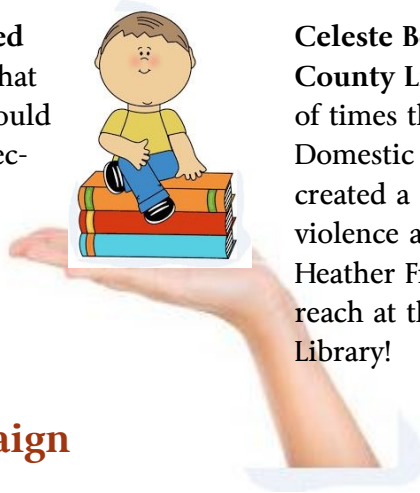


In August, The Quilcene Rangers high school football team invited Dove House to meet with the team and talk about how to prevent sexual assault. Team members asked questions and engaged in a discussion about state laws, consent, sexual coercion and how to establish and respect healthy boundaries.

We applaud Trey Beathard and the whole team for their openness to talk about these topics. This is one important step towards creating a culture in which sexual violence is not tolerated.

October was Domestic Violence Awareness Month. 5 million U. S. children live in households where there is domestic violence. 40 million U. S. adults grew up in a home with domestic violence. Domestic violence is the 3rd leading cause of homelessness in the U. S. Thank you for joining with us as we support whole families who are struggling to find safety and heal from trauma.

In October, Dove House hosted **Jumping Mouse** for lunch so that staff from both organizations could meet and learn about our respective services, priorities, and challenges. We appreciate Jumping Mouse for their dedication to therapeutic opportunities for children.

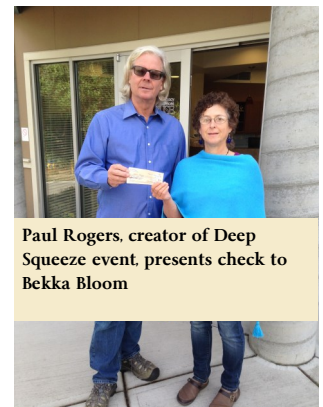

Introducing Kelly Grace, Birth & Family Advocate

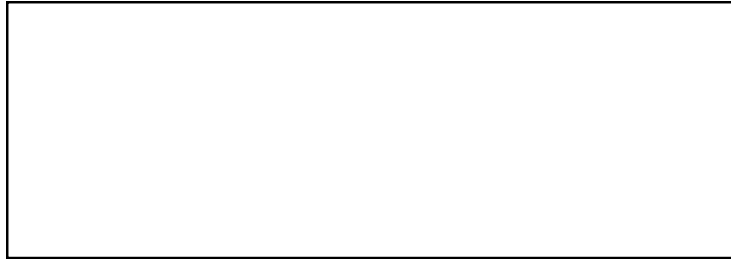

She is passionate about working with both children and adults in the realms of parenting, birth and breastfeeding advocacy, and trauma-informed healing including play therapy. After a recent session with Kelly, the kids playfully hopped down the hall. Their light-heartedness inspired mom, the therapist and other staff to join in. "Healing can be challenging; finding joy helps make the journey possible. At Dove House I get to use my education, personal life experiences, and birth and family training to achieve connection and advocacy with families of our community. I am honored and touched by the vulnerable places I get to work and beautiful people I get to work with to make the world a healthier place every day."
